

AV CHECKLIST FOR CONCERTS

I. VISUALS

Main Screen Options:

LED Screen - versatile for its customisation capabilities both for visual effects and
other kind of content (highly recommended)

Projector Mappings - for visual effects but pre-configured as per the architectural design, customisable in brightness through the console

Design Content - visuals throughout the show should be unique, highly creative

and engaging on the eyes

Video Console & Software

Media Servers - to control content

- Capture Devices to input camera feed
- Live Camera for the live feed on the screens



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II. AUDIO

Main PA Options:

Three-way / Two-way Array System - adequate to cover the audience)
Pole Mounted Array System - for smaller compact space indoor show	s
Side fils - a compact array system or subs and tops for the stage	
Monitoring - 12 or 15 inch floor wedges depending on the stage size	
Wireless In ear - sound guide for performers	

Microphones

Wireless Handheld- dynamic microphones for performers, MCs or announcements
Wired – reliable and ideal to place on a stand for stationed musicians
Headworn - best for performances, musical dramas, singers actively moving or dancing
Instrument Mics
Di - for connectivity of the keyboards, guitars, etc
Instrument Stands
Notation stands

Accessories:

Audio Console – to enhance and blend all the instruments and voices to make a divine and complete sound (should be managed by professional)



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III. LIGHTING

Main Lighting:

Stage Lights - generic warm lights for the stage
Face Lights – ellipsoidal fixtures to focus the face of performers
Special Effects & Other Lighting:
Gobos - textured lights to create more depth in the event space
Wash Lights - to make the suitable vibe for each song
Blinders - to give an impactful hit at certain times and to light up the audience
Smoke & haze - a must for concerts, to give the lights more visibility.
Cold fire / Sparklers & Fire - additional wow factor for concerts to create impact
Lighting Console – to control lighting
Trussing - to hold the lighting fixtures and any other elements
